Public utilities join heritage gems, Commonwealth Games ready sports venues and inspiring buildings, homes, churches, schools, universities, museums, art galleries, TV and radio stations and workplaces that open for the event.

Gold Coast Open House is a free annual event that encourages people to visit buildings, places and spaces they might have read about or seen from the street.

It is based on the London model which launched in the 1990s and spread around the world, teaching architectural appreciation and encouraging people to think differently about the built environment.

Gold Coast Open House turns three this year with 40 buildings, places and spaces opening their doors.
